## Village Cemetery Sangerville Policy For New Addition

There are three (3) section in the new addition that are available.

Each Section contains twelve (12) plots. (Each plot is 20' wide by 10' long with a 2' border between plots).

Each plot contains six (6) lots. (Each lot is 3 1/3' wide by 10' long.)

Selling, Price and Sequential Order of Sale.

Enacted August 13, 2002 (Select Board Meeting)

**Head Stones** 

- 1. Lots will be sold for \$100 each, a full plot (six lots) will be \$600.
- 2. There will be no restrictions on the number of lot purchases, lots are to be sold in single lot increments.
- 3. In the Village Cemetery's new addition, constructed in 2002, lots are to be sold in sequential order, from Mill Street to Haley Construction, Inc. driveway (South going North) Plot 3, lot 1 in numerical order to Plot 1, lot 18. Can start the next row beginning with either Plot 4 or Plot 6, but lots must be sold in numerical order either lot 36 through to 19 or 19 to 36. Once a row is started it must continue in that numerical order. Next row can start with either Plot 7 or Plot 9, again with lots in numerical order. Once Section 1 is complete, go to Section 2 ( and so on through the cemetery)

Enacted
Each of the twelve (12) plots in the 1st section is marked on each corner with numbered markers starting with plot one (1) going south to plot three(3) and starting again in the next row starting with plot four (4) going south to plot six (6). Plots are separated by a 2' border. Each lot within the plot is 3 1/3' wide and 10' long. The head stone is to be placed on the west end edge within the lot, facing west at the head within the 3 1/3' and lined up with the other existing head stones. (See attached drawing for placement)
Trees, Shrubs, Ornaments and Other Enacted
Trees and shrubs can be planted or placed only under the authority and approval of the Select Board. Ornaments are to be cemetery appropriate and not an obstacle to the maintenance of the cemetery. Placement of flowers, flags and similar is traditional and befitting. All items need to be removed from the cemetery by October 15th to allow for the final maintenance before winter.
<u>Sexton</u> The Town's Sexton is to be contacted for arrangements of burial, placement and all other matters regarding burial and internment
