## TOWN WARRANT

Piscataquis, SS

State of Maine

To: Alvina Church, a resident of the Town of Sangerville, in said County of Piscataquis, State of Maine.

GREETINGS: In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sangerville, in the County of Piscataquis and the State of Maine, qualified to vote in Town affairs, to assemble at the Fire Station on Tuesday, July 25, 2017, at 6:30 PM in the evening, then and there to act on the following Articles, to wit:

### ARTICLES

ARTICLE 1: To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.

### PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

ARTICLE 2: To adopt the *Maine Moderator's Manual* published by the Maine Municipal's Association as the authority on the rules and procedures for conducting the Special Town Meeting.

ARTICLE 3: To ascertain if non-resident speakers are present and whether or not Inhabitants wish to call on them, to be heard.

ARTICLE 4: To see if the Town will name the established Recreation field location, the Sangerville Veterans' Memorial Park.

ARTICLE 5: To see if the Town will vote to approve adding the Wells' property, approved to purchase by Town vote at the March 29, 2014 Annual Town Meeting, to the established Sangerville Veterans' Memorial Park.

ARTICLE 6: To see if the Town will vote to (1)accept the donations in the total amount of \$8,318.13 received by the town between September 3, 2015 and June 26, 2017 and designated specifically for a multipurpose field at the "Sangerville Veterans' Memorial Park" and the "Gazebo Project" and appropriate those donations to the "Recreation Reserves" and "Gazebo Reserves" funds to offset costs associated with the Recreation/Park Committee projects of the same names and (2) authorize the Board of Selectmen to accept future donations designated for the same projects and to appropriate those donations to the "Recreation Reserves" and "Gazebo Reserves" funds as applicable.

ARTICLE 7: To see if the town will vote to accept the gift of the building and lot known as the Abbie Fowler School Building and lot from the Sangerville Historical Society, being the same premises described in the deed from the Town of Sangerville to the Sangerville Historical Society which is recorded at the Piscataquis County Registry of Deeds in Book 2300, Page 82, dated April 24, 2014. The Board of Selectmen is authorized to accept a quit claim deed on behalf of the Town.

ARTICLE 8: To see if the town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to sell the Abbie Fowler building and lot by such means and for such amount as the Board deems in the Town's best interest, after receiving recommendations from the Abbie Fowler Advisory Committee, and to issue a warranty deed to the buyer.
