## ARTICLES

## <u>ARTICLE 1</u>: To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.

Motion made and seconded to nominate Paul Davis for the Moderator. Paul was elected by the casting of three (3) ballots.

ARTICLE 2: To adopt the Maine Moderator's Manual published by the Maine Municipal's Association as the authority on the rules and procedures for conducting the Special Town Meeting.

Motion made and seconded to accept article #2 as read. Voters approved with a showing of hands to Adopt the Maine Moderator's Manual.

<u>ARTICLE 3</u>: To ascertain if non-resident speakers are present and whether or not Inhabitants wish to call on them, to be heard.

Motion made and seconded to accept Article #3 as read. Voters approved with a showing of hands to allow non-residents to speak at this meeting.

<u>ARTICLE 4</u>: To see if the Town will vote to appropriate \$125,000 from the General Fund for the purpose of Road Improvement.

Motion made and seconded to accept Article #4 as read. Voters approved with a showing of hands, nineteen (19) in favor and fourteen (14) opposed. Motion carries.

<u>ARTICLE 5</u>: To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to dispose of the following piece of Town-owned equipment: a 2000 John Deere tractor with snowblower and mowing deck attachments.

Motion made and seconded to accept Article #4 as read. Voters approved with a showing of hands, twenty-two (22) in favor and ten (10) opposed. Motion carries.

The Moderator asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:47pm. The motion was carried.
