**To: Lorna Bell, a resident of the Town of Sangerville, in said County of Piscataquis, State of Maine.**

**Deputy Town Clerk Sara Morey served as Election Clerk. Twenty-seven (27) registered Sangerville voters. The meeting was called to order at 6:00pm by the Town Clerk, Lorna Bell and the greeting was read.**

**GREETINGS:**

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sangerville, in the County of Piscataquis and the State of Maine, qualified to vote in Town affairs, to assemble at the Grace Bible Community Room, 40 Douty Hill Road, on Monday October 11, 2021, at 6:00 in the evening, then and there to act on the following Articles, to wit:

**ARTICLE 1:** To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.

**Motion was made and seconded to nominate Paul Davis, Sr. for Moderator. Three (3) ballots cast and Senator Paul Davis, Sr. was elected.**

**SILENCE:** A moment of silence will be observed.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE – was recited**

**ARTICLE 2:** To adopt the *Maine Moderator's Manual* published by the Maine Municipal Association as the authority on the rules and procedures for conducting the Special Town Meeting.

**Motion made and seconded to accept Article 2 as written and adopt the Maine Moderator's Manual by a showing of hands.**

**ARTICLE 3:** To ascertain if non-resident speakers are present and whether or not Inhabitants wish to call on them, to be heard.

**One (1) non-resident was present.**

**ARTICLE 4:** To see if the Town will vote to appropriate \$150,000.00 from the General Fund for the purpose of Paving.

**Recommended by the Board of Selectmen: \$150,000.00**

**Motion was made and seconded to accept Article 4 as written. The Article was voted on and passed by a showing of hands.**

**ARTICLE 5:** To see if the Town will vote to appropriate \$20,000.00 from General Fund for Public Works Projects and Expenses. (trench paving, brush cutting, culverts for next year)

**Recommended by the Board of Selectmen: \$20,000.00**

**Motion was made and seconded to accept Article 5 as written. The Article was voted on and passed by a showing of hands.**

**ARTICLE 6:** To see if the Town will vote to appropriate \$25,000.00 from the General Fund for Health and Sanitation.

**Recommended by the Board of Selectmen: \$25,000.00**


**Motion was made and seconded to accept Article 6 as written. The Article was voted on and passed by a showing of hands.**


**Recommended by the Board of Selectmen**


**Motion was made and seconded to accept Article 7 as written. The Article was voted on and passed by a showing of hands.**
