The salt and sand was delivered, and is now being mixed for winter. By next week, the Silvers Mills road should be ready for the binder coating. The ditches have also been deepened. Roundy's has not responded to the town manager's calls and emails about fixing the section of East Sangerville Road. Brian Howard, who has provided much of the materials suggested an HD (heavy duty) pavement, which is similar to what is on airstrips. It would take around 30 years before the road would need to be repaired instead of the usual 7 years.
